Member's Corner

Laura King is a relative newcomer to LAA and to the art world. But her beautiful glass jewelry has been a hit from day one. You might remember it from the Members'

Show in November.

Born in Cleveland but raised in Colorado, Laura is a psychologist by training and began doing stained glass as a hobby about six years ago. Over time, she developed an interest in fused glass. Curious about how it was made, she visited a studio in Highlands Ranch. "I made my first piece there, a retro looking sushi dish. When I was finished, I was hooked. I wanted to be able to do fused glass work at home." That was in 2006 and for her birthday, she received a glass fusing kiln from her husband. Through class work, books, and a lot of trial and error, she began to understand how fused glass works. In 2008 she decided to get a booth at the Louisville Street Faire and launched **Firefly Glass Arts**. While she doesn't have any formal art background, she does have experience in quilting and sewing as a hobby. "I see fused glass and quilting as similar because you are cutting pieces from fabric or glass and ultimately connecting the pieces back together to form a design."

A new member of LAA, Laura has volunteered to take over managing our grants program. Her work is currently on display at the Artful Culp coffeehouse in Louisville and will also be available at the Louisville Street Faire and the Louisville Farmers Market.
